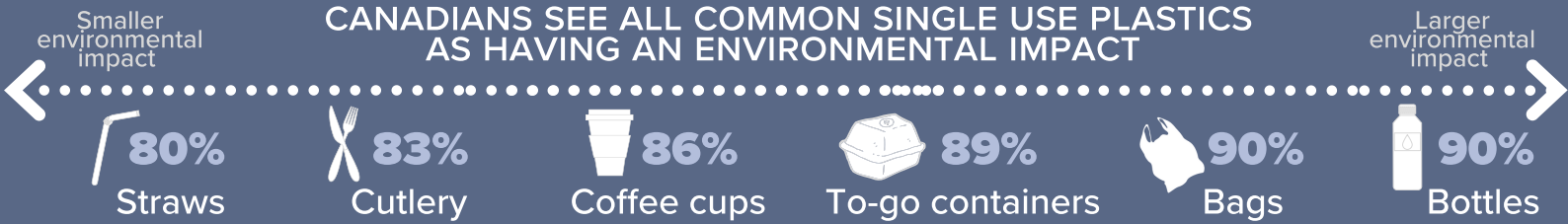

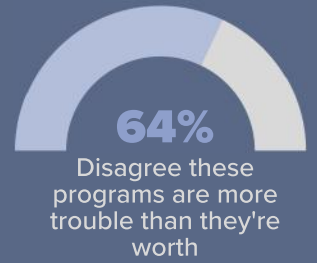
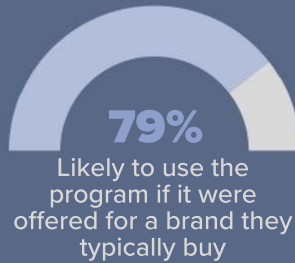
WHAT CANADIANS THINK OF SINGLE USE PLASTICS



- 88%** Agree all must do their part to reduce their usage
- 81%** Concerned about their environmental impacts
- 68%** Consume them every few days or more often

CANADIANS ARE WILLING TO USE A SUSTAINABLE REUSABLE PACKAGING PROGRAM INSTEAD
